
A Simple Homeless Camp Toilet

Black buckets as not as common and eventually become identifiable as toilet buckets. They often become soiled and discarded so it is good to have them be unique color.





Standard lids are helpful as people like to keep them in their tent if they only use them for urine as well as making it easier to assemble as a set for distribution



These toilet seats are distributed in the bag that the tent comes in.



These Hefty kitchen bags are available from Amazon. Half a box of these go in in the kits. The black color makes them a little less gross and is also unique.



There are usually good deals for clumping litter at Safeway. Just make sure it is in a sealable plastic container. Most brands work fine if the packaging is right. There are some lightweight varieties that are easier to haul around.




These tents are always available pretty cheap at Amazon. They are a bit flimsy, but they tend to get used up pretty quickly anyway. Using the same privacy tents them easy to identify.

Important: You must replace the stakes that are supplied as they are inadequate.



These 10½ stakes are good. You must replace the stakes that come with the tent with stakes like these. You can buy variations of these at most sporting goods stores as well.



Then add some hand sanitizer, disinfectant wipes and toilet paper.



Everything but the stakes and seat go in the bucket.



This leads to a very easy to carry package.
