There are many reasons why I love WAMC listeners and members.

You all understand that WAMC really is a cooperative organization. We certainly don't all agree on everything but when the crunch is on, when our continued existence depends on everyone putting something into the pot, you do just that. As we open letters to the Roundtable Panel each day, there is inevitably a salutation along the lines of, "I love the panel BUT..." What that means to me is that we are family -- at least we act like my family did. That's why when we made our first million-dollar goal, it took my breath away. I'll bet it took yours away, too.

We remember back to those times when it literally took us weeks to raise \$100,000. It was both painful and joyful. Staff hung on to one another for emotional support and we all showed up early in the morning, bleary eyed; it seemed like we never left the microphones. Then, as now, all kinds of people showed up with food and everyone seemed to know everyone else among the volunteers. It really was inspirational; it gave you faith that even though things looked hopeless at times, people could still get together and work miracles. We would play Pete Seeger and Ray Charles and even Kate Smith singing God Bless America, over and over again. We played The 2000 Year Old Man until the grooves on the record wore out (yes, it was a record), not to mention Tubby The Tuba with its terrific message for all: "Oh, Tubby, can I play that tune too?" At one point, we heard from the son of the Tubby creator who seemed to proud that his father was being honored by this radio station. That sure made my day.

And, little by little, it stopped being just a radio station -- it became a place where we could all come and celebrate our diversity and ideas. I always think back to the time when the US was involved in one of its foreign adventures. A local man walked into a tee shirt store in a mall and bought a shirt with the message "Peace on Earth" on it. Despite the fact that he bought the shirt right there in the mall, he was promptly arrested for breaking some kind of "no politics" law. That was the whole fund drive from the moment we learned about it. That serendipitous kind of thing happened a lot and we were all, once again, reminded about freedom of speech.

I am reminded about a time when a nearby radio/tv conglomerate asked me to come over to pitch during their fund drive. I said yes and arrived and started to do my own off the cuff thing. The director ran over to my and sternly said, "Dr. Chartock, we don't do it that way here. We stay with script." The script! Are you kidding? The fund drives are often referred to as FUN drives. That's when we can really cut loose. Well, they're still in business doing it their way but we will never stop doing it our way.

Sure, some people will take offense any time they can at anything. Just catch me eating a bagel on the air and outrage will follow. People can be strange that way. But hey, despite the outrage they almost preface their note with the provision that they give to the station. As Pete Seeger always said, "Take it easy, but take it."

And speaking of Pete Seeger, he was our extraordinary patron saint who I miss each and every day. Yes, that Pete who gave us his last concert shortly before he died because, as he said, "I want to do something for the station." Pete will always be part of our collective memory and history just as each and every one of you will be.

This month we celebrate the American workforce, now more than ever. As many have had to adapt to new working conditions, taking on multiple jobs and working remotely, we come to realize there's nothing we can't do! Many non-essential workers who set up home offices during the pandemic are excited to be back in the workplace; however, and as the air cools down, we are also excited to greet the fall season. To keep in step with the new month, new season, new school year and new way of life, WAMC has a few new programs, too.

PROGRAMMING CHANGES

After 27 amazing years, WBUR has made the difficult decision to end production of "Only A Game." "Only A Game" currently airs Saturday mornings at 7 a.m. The last episode will air September 26.

American Public Media will also end production of "Live from Here." "Live from Here," previously "A Prairie Home Companion," has and always will hold a spot in the hearts of public media listeners. "Live from Here" will be replaced by "American Routes" on Saturday evenings at 6 beginning September 5. "American Routes" previously aired Tuesday nights.

WAMC is excited to bring you "World Café," produced by WXPB in Philadelphia. Hosted by Raina Douris, "World Café" presents interviews and performances with today's essential and emerging artists with contemporary music that includes an eclectic blend of blues, rock, world, folk, and alternative country. "World Café" airs Tuesdays at 8 p.m. beginning September 1.

SPECIAL PROGRAMMING

Labor Day: "Tanglewood on Parade," an archival concert from its 2019 season will feature Tchaikovsky's "Hamlet," and an interview with composer and conductor James Burton. We'll also hear Copland's "Ceremonial Fanfare," Dukas' "Fanfare from La Peri" and Berlioz's "Roman Carnival Overture." The three-hour performance will air at 9 a.m.

Labor Day afternoon: Former United States National Security Advisor Brent Scowcroft died in early August. WAMC will air an archival Dow Mel lecture by Scowcroft at 2 p.m.

Late September: WAMC will prepare listeners for the upcoming election by airing "America, Are We Ready?" a three-part series featuring national conversations on the themes of labor, the pandemic, and racial justice.

The series has adapted to bring Americans together around unpredictable and unprecedented challenges. Join WNYC's Brian Lehrer, guests and listeners for "America, Are We Ready for the Election?: Labor, the Pandemic, and Race," airing live, September 22, 23, 24 from 8-10 p.m.

REGULAR PROGRAMMING

Coming up this month on "The Academic Minute": Schools are back in session, and you can supplement your virtual or in-person learning with some cutting-edge research each weekday. We'll feature a full week of segments from the University of Michigan, including segments on COVID-19, race and gender identity. Other weeks will include professors discussing the coming teacher shortage, interracial friendships and what affects a teens' college choice. Stay tuned every Monday through Friday on WAMC at 7:30 a.m. and 3:56 p.m. and any time at academicminute.org.

This month on "Person Place Thing" we'll remember the late Sir Roger Bannister, who became the first man in history to run a sub-4-minute mile before beginning a distinguished career in neurology. Host Randy Cohen will also speak with actor Andrei De Shields (Hadestown, The Wiz), musician David Byrne and director of "The Lion King," Julie Taymor. "Person Place Thing" airs Friday evenings at 10:30 p.m. and Saturday mornings at 7:30 a.m.

Since the health of our community is extremely important to us, we are continuing our cancellation/postponement of events at The Linda, WAMC's Performing Arts Studio, until further notice. The Linda will continue its performances online with Open for Takeout, The Virtual Concert Series with performances taking place every Monday night at 8.
